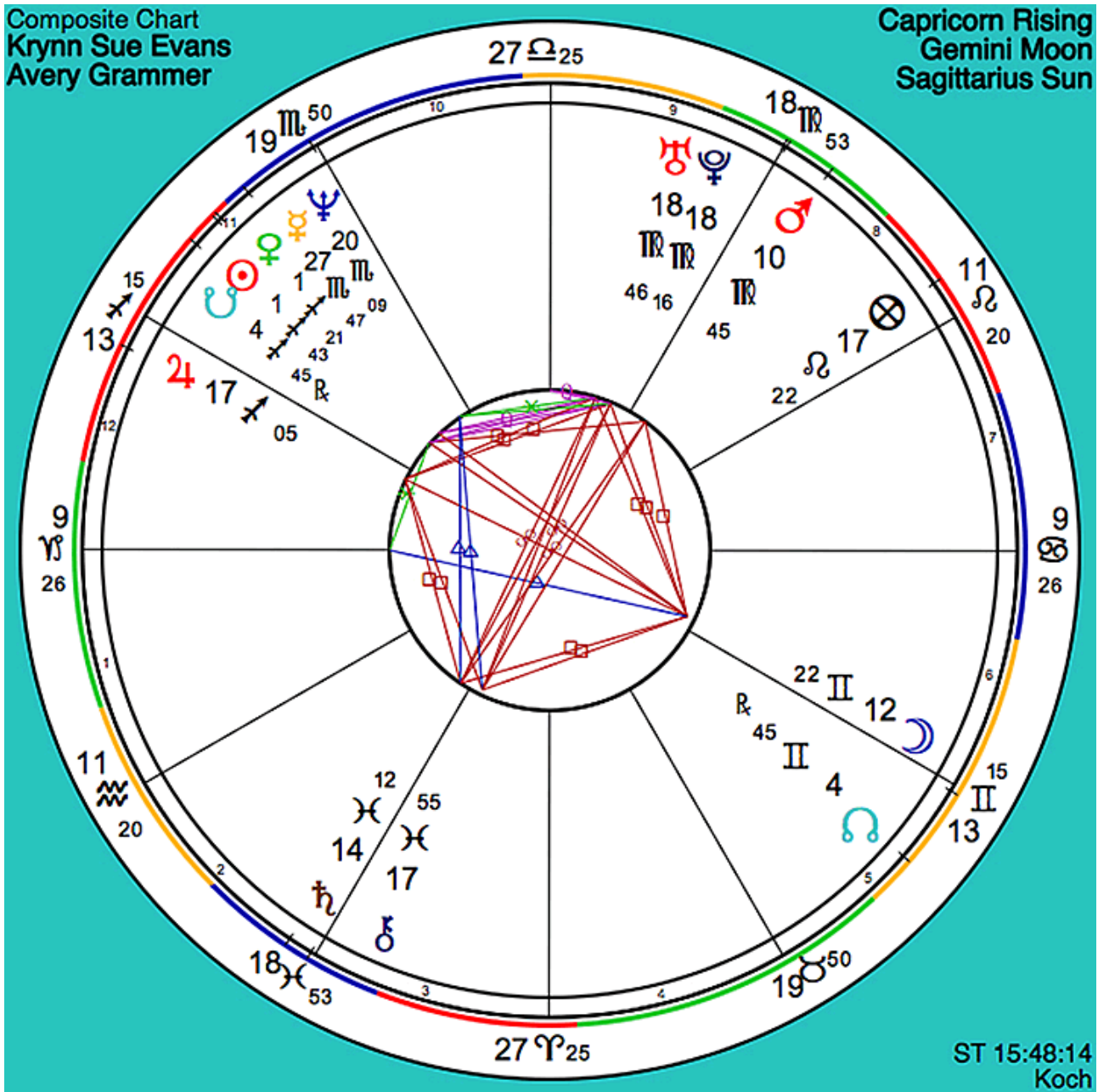

The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity, as this relates to the meaning for each individual within it.

Introduction

The Relationship Report for two individuals applies to any type of relationship. It focuses on the relationship itself, rather than on the individuals who make it up. First a composite chart (mid-point chart) is created. The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together in relationship. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity.

In the following report, each planetary placement and aspect is examined to reveal the basic qualities of your relationship, with the most important factors described first. Please keep in mind that these descriptions are not meant to put limitations on the relationship, but merely to describe its inherent tendencies. Challenging aspects can become the greatest strength of a relationship if you can both learn how to successfully navigate those issues, with good communication between you playing a vital role. For definitions of astrological terms, please refer to the glossary at the end of this report.

Chart Patterns

Funnel, focal planet Moon

You have the planetary pattern type called the 'funnel' shape. All your planets form a group, with the exception of the focal point, one planet or two planets in conjunction. Your energies tend to be channeled through this focus. You will have abilities in the occupied area of the chart, and goals in the direction of the focal point. The focal planet(s) symbolizes how your energies will be expressed, and where you seek to have your needs met or achieve your purpose.

The placement of the composite Moon defines the core emotional focus of your relationship. It indicates the most sensitive area between you.

The composite Moon in Virgo symbolizes a relationship that tends to provide a practical grounded quality in order to meet a need for emotional security.

Your relationship has a bent toward being hardworking and well organized. This placement bodes well for professional relationships as well as personal ones, because you are emotionally well equipped to attend to the details. In a romantic relationship, although the two of you may come off as somewhat reserved, or perhaps overly fastidious and analytical, you thrive on working in service to others, and you are likely to be well regarded because of it. One partner may feel the burden of domestic chores more than the other, and you can avoid the building up of resentment by taking turns. You profit when you make yourselves as aware as possible of attempting to change each other and those around you for the better, and when you remember that the easier you are on yourselves, and the more you take time out to enjoy life, the healthier and more vibrant you will remain in relationship to each other. The composite Moon in Gemini symbolizes a relationship where a high level of verbal communication and exchange provides a sense of emotional security between you. Together, you tend to keep in close touch and enjoy a shared glibness of tongue when conversing. This placement enhances your shared experience of the changing moment rather than the long term. While enjoying the smartness and versatility of your exchanges, you may also need to soften what can be an overly critical approach at times. In a romantic relationship, your ability to express your feelings to each other allows for great flexibility and mutual satisfaction between you. You will also never tire of conversation with each other. Together, you like to express your opinions, and tend to react to situations by thinking, rather than with feeling or direct action. T-Square, focal planet Mars, Pluto

You have a T-Square in your chart. With this planetary aspect pattern, in which three planets or conjunctions are in square with one another, you have a high degree of motivation and drive. Your energies are most easily and habitually expressed by the energy of the focal point, the middle of the T-Square. You may also compensate for overdoing in the area of life represented by the focal point, by leaning toward the empty pattern element opposite the focal point, seeking to balance your activity. The lesson of this planetary aspect pattern is in learning to use your considerable energy wisely in the pursuit of your true goals. There is great tension represented by

the focal planet or planets in your chart, where conflicting parts of your personality attain their focus and peak of energy, and you may observe compulsive behavior in the area of life represented here.

The placement of Mars in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared activity in pursuit of partnership goals, and where ego needs may be identified.

Mars in the Eighth House (or sign) brings out a passionate and intense drive in your relationship. You two tend to move in proud, strong-willed and stubborn ways, and you create a noticeable presence that will likely prove to be a powerful influence on those around you. It may work best if you make an effort to take this naturally competitive drive and consciously create a shared alliance around a specific activity such as joint investments or investigations. In a romantic context, your shared sexual energy is very important to both of you, making this an ideal placement for passionate involvement. Your joint instinct is powerful, and often confidently enacted. Composite Mars in Virgo (or the sixth house) brings out a kind energy between you with a strong, shared drive for work and service. Together, you possess a tremendous desire to be helpful to others. You make a practical and hard-working duo with an ability to hit the nail on the head and complete tasks that you have set out for yourself. You may perhaps need to work through getting into conflicts over trifles at times. In a romantic context, you have a serious rather than a playful attitude toward shared activity. There may be a tendency for unsynchronized timing to arise between you, such when one wants to be served by the other unequally, but these difficulties can yield to a well-developed patience and a sense of humor. You may find

greater fulfillment in your relationship when you take turns serving each other. It may prove helpful to you as a partnership to set your exacting sights on wider vistas. Pluto in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter your mutual drive for power and which will be transformative for the relationship.

Pluto in the Ninth House (or sign) correlates with a relationship that is focused on higher-mind understanding and moral or ethical belief systems, perhaps excessively. You two have a heightened capacity for objective introspection and deep truth telling. Together you may have a strong drive to express your ideas to each other and to others in your sphere of influence. You may need to combat potentially dogmatic responses to the ideas of others, or a tendency to regard your particular philosophy or cause as the only one. In a romantic connection, you are likely to try to influence each other regarding your philosophy of life or shared belief system. If you agree on your basic beliefs, then this area may represent a powerful focus for you, with a life-changing quality to it, but if you disagree there may be trouble in settling down into a common groove. You benefit when you learn to let your partner's ideas coexist with your own, without needing to fix the situation, and when you speak to each other absolutely honestly in order to allow for a free and easy expression of ideas between you. You may find you are working through very deep-seated unconscious dynamics of

being truly helpful and available to others. In a romantic relationship, in order to prevent power struggles that inevitably play out within the issues of sharing and service to each other, it is important that you carefully turn the light of consciousness onto the working dynamics of the relationship. In spite perhaps of a culture that does not encourage it, you benefit when you develop an ability to mutually acknowledge the power dynamics at play, and to begin to cultivate a very real and sincere humility, or take the time to access built-up and unresolved emotions within you, and just let it be. Composite Saturn in Pisces (or the twelfth house) makes for an odd match, bringing a blockage or a concentration of energy to a power that is as vast and diffuse as the ocean itself. You also may find that you possess a joint focus on the mystical side of life. In a romantic relationship, you may trigger in each other, or help elucidate in each other, the feeling that

Chiron in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter patterns of wounds and deep connection and where eventual healing and empathy will occur.

Chiron in the Third House (or sign) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity for you both to face and heal deeply held wounds regarding the development of the intellect and the communication of one's ideas with others. With this placement you may both feel an almost compulsive curiosity regarding other people. You are likely to share a strong desire to communicate and to explore your world intellectually, but you may feel a barrier that separates you from each other and those around you at the same time. These feelings of being blocked in your ability to communicate can even manifest physically in the form of a very obvious breakdown in your communication. Though these problems may seem almost physical, the physical and the mental are so intimately related it can be hard to say. Talents may arise that come from beyond this world, and you may discover renewed passion for music, poetry, or spirituality. You may be reminded of painful episodes from early childhood that drove you into a world of your own. You have likely come to be quite at home in your inner world, and your challenge is to take advantage of this relationship to come out with style and dignity, with your inner cosmos intact. Again and again, when you attempt to be a part of it all, just like everyone else, you find it doesn't quite work. You may work with other people, helping them to be peaceful and comfortable in connecting their own lives to a higher truth, without ever really getting it yourself. You may also compensate for overdoing in the area of life represented by the focal point, by leaning toward the empty pattern element opposite the focal point, seeking to balance your activity. You are likely to enjoy the exploration of new horizons together, either mentally or through travel, and you might need to be ready to jump into the car at a moment's notice. You share a powerful sense of optimism and a tendency for reckless behavior at times, since together you may not always look before you leap, and you benefit from exercising caution when it is appropriate to do so. As a partnership you possess high ideals, and share a capacity to visualize new possibilities rather than accept an outmoded status quo. One or the other of you

You value being good and kind, and these values are magnified by your relationship with each other. You also tend to be considerate, friendly and easy-going in the context of this relationship. If you are business partners, you likely need to feel an emotional sympathy in order for your work to be satisfying to you. Together, you have your own personal code of conduct to which you are true, no matter what public opinion may be, or convention may dictate. In a romantic connection, as a couple you are likely to be fond of cinema, or other imaginative flights of fancy. There is some danger of escapism. Composite Mercury in Scorpio (27° Sco 47')

Composite Mercury in the Eleventh House

Mercury in the composite chart reveals the quality of the communication process in your relationship, and an area of your shared experience where intellectual compatibility is to be found.

Composite Mercury in Aquarius brings a balanced and socially oriented mentality out in this relationship, one that is insightful, analytical and detached. You two tend toward an inquisitive and scientific orientation, with excellent joint powers of logic and reason. Your communication is idealistic in its nature, yet remains also well-grounded in reality. Together, you two are a

good judge of character and likely work well with groups. You have a shared aesthetic appreciation of the things in this world that often depends on their utility and ultimate purpose. As a partnership you also have the capacity to multitask, handling many tracks of thinking at once until they all finally come together in a manifest whole. Whether your relationship is personal or professional, it has a strong social motivation, and strives in its communication and contact with others to advance the cause of humanitarian ideals.

Composite Mercury in Scorpio gives a very intensely careful and controlled quality to the communication in your relationship. You tend to make joint plans slowly, and stick to them resolutely. Your shared mental and observational powers are strong and your thoughts as a partnership run deep. You two tend to desire to connect with each other in a profound way. You may not immediately express your ideas; instead choosing to get your point across nonverbally, or when you decide that the time is right. You may also have a tendency to make judgments about each other and those around you. It benefits your relationship if you each make a practice of acceptance and understanding of each other. This bodes well for the two of you as long as you live from what is alive in you and not from fear or defensiveness. Your joint will is strong, and you have a passion for discovering the truth behind surface appearances. You tend to penetrate the depths of any subject. Composite Venus in Sagittarius (1° Sag 21')

Composite Venus in the Eleventh House

The placement of Venus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared emotional focus and love and where mutual enjoyment and benefit lies.

Venus in the Eleventh House (or sign) there is a solid basis of friendship between you and a shared propensity to network with others. Your relationship thrives on mutually agreed upon goals and an appreciation of group activity in support of social agendas that you favor. If you have a common group affiliation it is likely that you shine together in a leadership

position within it. In a romantic relationship this propensity that you have for agreement on societal goals adds meaning beyond the emotional connection that you share with each other, or may also become a distraction from it. At least you always have a solid understanding of where the other partner is coming from. As a partnership you excel in areas of group interaction and future orientation, with a scientifically detached outlook and a genial humanism that colors your approach. You may be just the ones, acting in concert, to bring much-needed ideas to collective concerns or to press for the integration of society into a more unified whole.

Composite Sun in Sagittarius (1° Sag 42' 41")

Composite Sun in the Eleventh House

The placement of the composite Sun defines the core identity of your relationship, and the place where it finds its greatest vitality. It gives you a sense of the predominant flavor of the relationship.

With the Composite Sun in Aquarius, this relationship centers on eccentric interests, progressive thinking and innovative breakthrough. Through this relationship each of you is likely to display a rebellious nature, with a focus on spontaneous and original behavior. Aquarius is forward thinking and detached, and together, you two are likely to work in ways that are somewhat ahead of your time. Thinking is your preferred mode of activity.

Your partnership is likely to give rise to the scientific and logical, and exude a confidence in manner. In a romantic pairing, you may find you maintain your focus on the value of society rather than on each other personally, and must set your intention to nurture affection and love between you. Regardless of your individual predilection, through the agency of this relationship you two may also find that you enjoy focusing on your individual or shared work more than personal goals, which makes this a great placement for colleagues and co-conspirators. Composite Neptune in Scorpio (20° Sco 09')

Composite Neptune in the Eleventh House

Neptune in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter idealization and nebulous spiritual feelings that will lead you to self-discovery.

Neptune in the Eleventh House (or sign) brings a visionary quality to your relationship. You make a popular duo, and may have a wide circle of friends.

You are likely to highly value the friendships that you have, and to find a source of joy and inspiration in each other. Your abiding sense of comradeship will carry you far, although the idealism that you share regarding social connection can also lead to confusion or illusion of what is really going on in these settings. (within 5.7 degrees) with Ascendant**

**Composite Sun in strong conjunction
(within 0.4 degrees) with Venus**

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.
This conjunction between composite Sun and Venus brings a warm-hearted and affectionate quality to your relationship. You generally find it easy to enjoy life and its pleasures together. You tend to have similar interests and a shared sense that it doesn't matter what you end up doing; you simply enjoy being together. As a twosome, you tend to come off as cheerful, charming and likable. In a romantic relationship, this placement can enhance an erotic desire to express love. You present well in public and will have an easy time getting doors to open for you. This is the most meaningful aspect that Sun and Venus can make, and when you find it present in your relationship, you may consider that you have found a true companion.

**Composite Sun in strong conjunction
(within 2.5 degrees) with Midheaven**

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.
With this conjunction between composite Sun and the Midheaven, your relationship has a concentrated focus on intention and a powerful

achievement orientation. You may have come together for a quite specific purpose, and whatever that purpose is you will likely succeed at it. This is a great placement for business partnerships and for friendships with a mutual goal in mind. In a romantic relationship, you have a commonality of vision that is helpful, and an active orientation to joint projects that you wish to undertake. You may wind up in business together, or provide excellent support each other in your individual career objectives. A drawback is that your relationship may be more susceptible to matters of prestige and other outside influence than you would like. You are both liable to become very involved with career and outer world affairs, perhaps to the detriment of more private and domestic issues, and this relationship brings out those qualities. Composite Sun in quintile

(within 1.0 degrees) with Uranus

With this aspect between composite Sun and Uranus, your relationship has an eccentric and uniquely idealistic quality. You two are determined to do things your own way, and love freedom from conformity. Together, you tend to explore all things new and unusual as a matter of course. This aspect between composite Sun and Pluto signifies a powerful intensity of connection between you. You may have experienced a fated quality when you first met, a feeling of recognition that you perhaps belong to the same tribe, or come from the same far away place. Whatever the basis for your relationship, it benefits you to train your considerable energy on the cultivation of the yin qualities of vulnerability, surrender and cooperation. Composite Moon in strong square (within 1.6 degrees) with Mars

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Moon and Mars brings a powerful emotional and potentially argumentative presence to your connection with each other. Emotional conditions easily influence you. The more demanding parts of your interactions together may challenge the supportive elements of your relationship. Together you tend to experience a sometimes difficult and at other times harmonious give and take, meeting each other in profound and penetrating ways. Regardless of how either of you behave on your own, you may find that together, you respond to each other in unusually formal, or even rigid, ways. Watch for a tendency to withhold feelings, or to stop yourselves before completing a thought or an action. This formality tends to work well in a professional environment. other's process and teammates working toward a shared goal. It benefits this relationship to take everything more slowly than your knee-jerk reaction would dictate, commit carefully, and then fall back on all your good vibes with each other when things get bogged down with the inevitable snags that come along with day-to-day reality.

**Composite Moon in square
(within 5.9 degrees) with Pluto**

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Moon and Pluto signifies a powerful emotional intensity in the connection between you and highlights a moody and introspective quality in your relationship. You may each exhibit something of a power drive, especially in domestic areas or in how you give to and nurture each other. In a romantic relationship especially there are likely to be boundary issues, or issues of codependence, or possessiveness, that come up between you. These emotional issues can lead to stormy weather between you from time to time. Actually, these issues may lie in wait for weeks and even months before showing themselves, but whether acknowledged or not they are part and parcel of your relationship just the same. The purpose of such a focus on these powerfully constellated emotions that come up between you is to help to bring them to the surface for eventual healing. These may be symptoms that reflect hidden insecurities that rule your behavior from largely unconscious levels of your personality. This relationship challenges you to transform your sense of insecurity by coming to terms with your survival issues based on deep, safe exploration. You may feel an urge to break through emotional limitations that get in the way between you, and this can aid you in healing childhood wounds. Learn to communicate about all the feelings that swim under the surface between you, and you are empowered to discover your core needs. If you allow yourself to change, you have an opportunity to transform your joint sense of insecurity by coming to terms with your survival issues based on a better insight into your own hidden motivations.

Composite Moon in square (within 5.6 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect in your composite chart symbolizes a relationship in which there is difficulty with the feminine and nurturing side of life, and also great potential for healing these areas as you work together. Of course the important early model for the feminine is mother, and it is likely that one or both of you experienced some degree of painful episodes there. If there were such traumas in your early relationship with your own mother or significant female parental figure, in the course of this relationship these may be helped toward resolution. In a marriage partnership, there may also be issues to be healed with your children, and the mothering and nurturing that they require. Role models may also come into play here, as you expand your understanding of who you really are in the context of this relationship. Issues with mother are of course endemic in both modern and ancient culture, as typified in mythology. Perhaps you had a close relationship, but yet your needs were somehow not met, resulting in unconscious resentments which only surfaced later in your adult life. With this aspect between composite Mars and Saturn, your relationship has a responsible, centered and hard-working quality that also might be experienced as a blockage of activity. Together, you possess a strong desire for freedom of expression that does not easily find its realization. You may share a desire but become inhibited in the process of acting on it. You'll think of a great idea, and then share only half of it, or you'll know exactly what the job takes, but stumble in trying to demonstrate it. As frustrating and even despairing as this placement can be, when you can summon the strength of purpose to work through these difficulties you gain in strength and courage, and over time may gain a better foundation for action. It benefits you to be tolerant with the range of feelings that arise between you in this process, making room for shyness, stiffness, or a desire to control or lash out. As you support each other to cultivate both courage and compassion, you have the potential to overcome your fears of self-expression and come to a more loving understanding of yourselves and each other.

**Composite Jupiter in square
(within 2.9 degrees) with Saturn**

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect brings to the relationship a serious and conscientious quality with

however a tendency toward the impractical. Though the two of you are motivated to achieve success, you will likely run into some self-imposed barriers on the road to achieving it. There may be a gap between your ambition and what you actually can accomplish. You tend not to be content with the extent of your responsibilities until you have taken on too much, leading to the problem of actually fulfilling these obligations. As a partnership, you also may have too limited and narrow a view of your potential, so that you aim too low, and garner less than you are capable of. This could lead to problems with material well being, or a tendency toward being too cautious and thrifty for your own good. Your relationship benefits from cultivating a more confident and generous attitude, and finding greater contentment with your present resources.

Composite Saturn in opposition (within 4.1 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between composite Saturn and Pluto brings forcefulness to your partnership as formidable as a tidal wave and as transformational as a bonfire is to a pile of wood. With this placement, you find yourself part of relationship that comes with a focus on issues of authority, power and control, with also the benefit of radical transformation. Saturn represents the controlling powers-that-be, while Pluto represents the urge to transform or destroy this status quo, and in your relationship these energies are in conflict. In personal relationships, you may have to beware of turning this immense force onto each other. It may be that one or both of you have had painful experiences as a child, when you were forced to submit to an arbitrary authority or limitation of some kind. The relationship with your father was damaged in some way; it was something you had to get away from, either from his overbearing nature or from his neediness and lack of presence. These wounds can manifest in adult life as an attachment and also great difficulty with authority. For example you may endlessly achieve positions of authority and then have second thoughts about it. Composite N Node in the Fifth House

Lunar North Node in the Fifth House (or sign). South Node in the eleventh house or sign. This placement in a composite chart signifies that within this relationship you each have a focus on being recognized and admired for the personal creativity that you manifest. You are fortunate in this lifetime, for few people have the capacity, as the two of you do, of actually making your dreams come true. You are engaged through the agency of this relationship in a process of concretizing your thought images, turning the products of your extraordinarily clever intellects into actual manifestation in the world. Composite Lunar North Node in Gemini (or the third house). South Node in the ninth house or sign. This placement in a composite chart signifies that within this relationship you have the desire for clear and direct communication skills. You are interested in the practical application of

knowledge, rather than information simply for the sake of it. This speaks to an issue that one or both of you may feel as though from past lifetimes, that you sometimes get into solitary philosophical concerns in a way that is divorced from the more real world orientation of active one-on-one communication. You especially value being truthful within this relationship, and find that clearly expressing yourself to each other is an important partnership goal. Your mental abilities serve your purpose well. Perhaps religious values are quite important to you, but now, especially in the context of this relationship, your focus is on a more mundane or worldly view, where higher knowledge counts, but only in so far as it is useful in order to spread the word to others.

Other Aspects

Composite Mercury in strong conjunction (within 1.5 degrees) with Midheaven

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.
With this conjunction between composite Mercury and the Midheaven, your relationship has a strong mental focus with the potential for heady conversation. You may have come together to practice some form of communication oriented business venture. You undoubtedly have a powerful communication orientation in your relationship, and converse well on many topics together. In a romantic relationship you may feel the need to balance your head with your heart. The excellent communication that you share will compensate for many difficulties, but a strong emotional basis must also be an important component of your shared connection. As a team you have a terrific ability to reach out verbally to the world outside your partnership, either in spoken or written form, with a restless curiosity that touches on many subjects. You may enter into a joint writing project or encourage others to do the same. Leavening your wit and wisdom with an emotional depth and sharing it in that way with society around you gives you the best of both worlds.

Composite Venus in strong conjunction (within 2.1 degrees) with Midheaven

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

With this conjunction between composite Venus and the Midheaven, your relationship has a good focus for joint activity and perhaps a shared mission for beauty and the arts. You are both likely to be very wrapped up in the relationship, and have an essentially effortless time getting along together. You sense that you have the same set of priorities and easily combine your activities. In a romantic connection, this aspect is an excellent indicator of harmony between you and mutual goals that you have in common. You are gracefully present with each other and put the relationship first, even though you are each able to stand on your own two feet as well. **Composite Jupiter in strong square
(within 1.7 degrees) with Uranus**

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This combination brings a socially conscious, optimistic and intuitive quality to your relationship, and you two share a gift for working with groups. You have a strong sense of optimism, possess high ideals and motivate others through your inventive and original example. You enjoy exploring new horizons, either real or imagined, and tend not to value security as much as you value an ever-expanding sense of freedom. You share a penchant for committing outlandish acts for the sheer heck of it, which provides you with tremendous entertainment, and occasionally tremendous stress. **Composite Jupiter in strong square
(within 1.2 degrees) with Pluto**

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This combination brings a fatefully determined quality to your relationship and an intense mandate to develop your powers to the fullest. You might feel as if you are reflecting a change-or-die mentality that can create a powerful intensity between you that turns small disagreements into major battles. **Composite Uranus in strong conjunction
(within 0.5 degrees) with Pluto**

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This combination in your composite chart reveals a relationship with a strong will and great depth of passion. Together, you are tuned in to the energy of the collective to an unusual degree, with a special focus on the ultimate transformation of society. You share a keen intuition and great power to transform yourselves and your relationship as you evolve as a partnership. You also tend to bring great force to bear in expressing your opinions about how this is best accomplished. You benefit when you work to develop tolerance, diplomacy and tact as you boldly make your way through the world. In a romantic connection, you may share an unconventional approach where sexual matters are concerned. **Composite Uranus in strong opposition
(within 0.8 degrees) with Chiron**

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect in your composite chart your relationship has a strong spiritual connection with it's own unique brand of philosophical outlook. As a partnership, you are likely to be prone to sudden insights and departures from consensus thinking. One or both of you probably has an unusual

combination of personality traits in which you are very unconventional yet also somewhat unsure of yourself in your very departure from the rest of society, so that you may surprisingly show flashes of a conservative side. **Composite Neptune in strong sextile
(within 1.9 degrees) with Pluto**

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This aspect between composite Neptune and Pluto is a generational aspect that many of your contemporaries will share, and indicates a relationship that is very attuned into the collective, both in its conscious and more unconscious aspects. You share a subtle intuition and unusually clear insight into others.

Because the influence of the unconscious is especially strong in your relationship, it benefits you both to connect with your deepest, highest selves in order to be happy. You are part of a dawning awareness that we that cannot help but be part of creating a new paradigm for life on planet earth. You function at your best together when you are in service to the world, helping increase awareness of interconnectedness and oneness.

**Composite Pluto in strong opposition
(within 0.4 degrees) with Chiron**

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect in your composite chart you are likely to be engaged in a relationship in which there is difficulty and also great healing potential around issues of power and control. There may also be compulsive behavior on the part of one or both partners that comes up for greater acceptance and eventual healing during the course of this relationship. As a result of your life

experiences before coming together, one or both of you may have a tendency to plunge into the depths of despair or the heights of manic madness as a form of compensatory reaction to over-indulgence in one form or another of a compulsive desire nature, perhaps expressed in terms of sexuality or abuse of power. Potent healing abilities are ultimately indicated with this placement, but you must first work through some tough issues, and this relationship can be life changing in that regard. Of course the relationship will be an important testing ground where power and control issues emerge, and where a tremendous increase in consciousness around them may result, but that is only the first step. Composite Mercury in conjunction (within 3.6 degrees) with Venus

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This aspect between composite Mercury and Venus lends ease and charm to your interactions. You two actually enhance each other's ability to communicate, often finding just the right words to express a feeling. You are likely to drop into very creative conversations together, and you write as well as you speak. Together, you are friendly and sociable, with a strong leaning toward the artistic and beautiful side of life. Your relationship exudes an extremely persuasive force in a quiet way. Just be sure not to use the grace inherent in your communication to candy coat things that need to be spoken in clear, strong light. Mercury and Venus aspects also address the background of the relationship, the space between the words and the quality of the connection in between direct encounters. With the conjunction, you

two share a strong intuitive link and tend to feel each other's presence even when you are days and worlds apart.

**Composite Venus in quintile
(within 0.6 degrees) with Uranus**

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

This aspect between composite Venus and Uranus brings to your relationship an eccentric and unconventional method of relating to each other, with a unique ability to come together in new ways. There is something very immediate about the connection between the two of you. You benefit when you can bring a more consistent focus to your many interests and activities together, and when you allow space for your shared need for freedom.

**Composite Venus in quintile
(within 1.1 degrees) with Pluto**

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

With this aspect between composite Venus and Pluto, your relationship has a magnetic quality and a passionate intensity for shared interests and a shared focus on forming a close emotional attachment with each other. You may experience challenge in marriage and romantic partnership, and yet also gain great rewards in terms of healing your mutual issues of closeness and dependency. Your intense feelings for each other can lead to a harmonious blending of your energies, lending a powerful faith to your joint activity. With wisdom and love, you can transform any difficult issues that you encounter with each other into a growing and conscious act of sharing.

**Composite Uranus in quintile
(within 1.5 degrees) with Midheaven**

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

This aspect between composite Uranus and the Midheaven brings to your relationship and its purposeful intention a sense of the unconventional. There may be some higher purpose that has brought you together, but it lies in wait for you to discover through time. In a romantic connection, you benefit when you do not seek to put any rules down for what you mean to each other. You

will do better when you allow things to develop in their own way and give credit to your evolving mutual intuition of where the two of you are headed. It may be that together you will find involvement in the science of future social development or a new thought orientation.

**Composite Neptune in trine
(within 2.2 degrees) with Chiron**

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial. With this aspect in your composite chart you have in your relationship a strong spiritual connection and an almost psychic sympathy with each other, based on your own experiences in these sensitive areas. One or both of you is likely to have particularly strong access to the world of dreams and inner fantasy, which may serve as an escape valve. If so, there may be a wound to your sense of place in this physical world. You may be extremely sensitive to the energy of others, and vicariously experience their pain, or allow yourself to be overly influenced by their opinion of you. (within 1.0 degrees) with Midheaven**

This aspect between composite Pluto and the Midheaven brings to your relationship a passionate intensity and also a great potential for personal

evolution. There is a depth to your connection with each other that may not seem obvious on the surface, but which over time you find is there. In a romantic connection, the possibility is there for adherence to and departure from issues of who has the authority at any given moment. The sexual arena is one place that these control issues may manifest. As a partnership you make a dedicated and charismatic pairing, and can accomplish great things together once you figure out where and how far you want to go in order to make your strongest contribution to the society that surrounds you.

Composite Sun in weak opposition (within 10.7 degrees) with Moon

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect between composite Sun and Moon, your relationship lives under a creative tension of opposites that attract. You two are likely to share a palpable, dynamic interchange that creates a willful and strong-minded sense of purpose together. In romantic relationship, you generate a high level of energy and an almost visible brightness, and you tend to be very aware and alert of each other from moment to moment. As different as the Sun is to the Moon, so you two may find yourselves harboring two distinct approaches to the relationship, approaches that you may need to work to harmonize. You may need to bridge the mental and willful parts of yourselves with the more instinctual and emotional parts as you work out your relationship. You also may experience a conflict within your unit between public and private, or between the work you set out to accomplish together and your domestic goals. You can have a tendency to argue these issues out and it benefits you to learn the arts of compromise and compassion. This dynamic tension may lead you to accomplish much together in life, through the path of creative struggle rather than the path of ease and comfort.

Composite Sun in weak square (within 9.0 degrees) with Mars

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Sun and Mars brings a rash quality to your relationship, and a creative tension. You may find that you are restless

together, and that your individual tempers quicken. You may trigger each other so easily that you then act out impulsively, perhaps against your own better thinking. You will also likely find in yourselves a tendency toward argument based on a deep-seated need to be understood. On the other hand, your relationship possesses a forceful drive with the possibility of accomplishing great things. You two will never want for lack of excitement, and with each other you find inspiration to take risks you would not take on your own. It benefits you to learn to temper your strong physical drive together with calmness and discretion, and to develop creative outlets that make good use of your joint fire.

**Composite Sun in weak conjunction
(within 11.6 degrees) with Neptune**

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

With this conjunction between composite Sun and Neptune, your relationship has vision and creativity, with a high degree of sensitivity between you. You will find that your connection has an unworldly, ethereal side. There is an important spiritual connection that you share, and that may even be the reason that you have come together. You two bring out a softhearted quality in each other, and you may have to be careful that you don't sacrifice too much of yourselves in helping others. Your relationship thrives in its subtle body, but you may begin to suffer if you expect it to bear fruit in the material plane. There could be issues of idealism or fantasy, perhaps even outright deception that you will mutually work through in the course of this partnership. **Composite Moon in weak opposition
(within 11.0 degrees) with Venus**

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between composite Moon and Venus brings a loving, calm and steady presence to your relationship, although there can be a difficult edge from time to time. You tend to love luxury and refinement, and it is important to your relationship that you get to work and play with nice things. Together, you emanate social charm and attractiveness, and your loving disposition brings grace to any room you inhabit. This is a wonderful aspect for a romantic connection, and also serves well for parents or for professional colleagues working in an artistic environment. There may be complementary differences of opinion between you regarding what you expect to get out of any given situation. The trick here is to walk into your shared encounters knowing exactly what you want to get out of them, and stay focused. The same holds true for your shared relationship to money. Have patience with your partner's needs and desires. Together, you possess a great deal of personal charm, and also have a love for the arts, especially music and dance. You tend to be courteous and popular as a couple, and you go out of your way to be supportive to friends.

**Composite Moon in weak square
(within 6.4 degrees) with Uranus**

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

With this aspect between composite Moon and Uranus, your relationship has an eccentric and unique home base. Your connection is likely to be an unusual one, with a strong intuitive link between you. Things are never dull, although the resulting emotional instability can represent a challenge if one of you attempts to stay within the bounds of a more conservative approach. You two are likely to have changeable emotions, and may develop a reputation for

being unpredictable. In a business partnership, you may have come together around the concept of new ways of living. Novelty excites you both. In a romantic connection, you are likely to be extremely honest with each other, and this is a high virtue, although you may find that it gets a little abrasive from time to time. You don't do well with anything resembling boredom. You may change your residence frequently, or be always starting new projects and adventures. Your relationship can give rise to feelings of insecurity at

times, possibly because it will evoke memories of disruption from your early home lives. Composite Mercury in weak conjunction (within 7.6 degrees) with Neptune

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.
This conjunction between composite Mercury and Neptune indicates a clever and imaginative relationship that exudes a subtle charm. You tend to communicate with each other in visionary and poetic ways, and together you can express the normally inexpressible. Your conversations are likely to be inspired, with a deep appreciation of the arts, the imagination and the mystery, although there is also at least the potential for deceptive illusion between you. In a romantic relationship the danger is also that with such a strong connection between your conscious and unconscious minds, your shared sensitivity runs so high that engaging in other activities, even sexuality, can feel like coming down. You also might need to take care to more clearly discriminate between fantasy and reality, in order to avoid overly glamorizing each other or another focus of your shared idealizing. You can mutually profit from learning to clearly channel the truth that arises out of your joint thought process, being careful to discriminate the ideal and the sensible in day-to-day mundane issues. Composite Mars in weak conjunction (within 8.0 degrees) with Uranus

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.
This conjunction between composite Mars and Uranus brings to your relationship an eccentricity and that is refreshing and totally unconventional, with an original and eclectic mindset and a keen intuition. Your partnership with each other is definitely off the beaten path in one way or another. You

two are a strong-willed and nonconformist team, and you may develop your own unique code of ethics. Probably you came together suddenly, perhaps for some unusual purpose that you were not completely aware of at the time. Your shared goals may also change unexpectedly and dramatically as time goes on, and resist all efforts to define them. Together, you may make sudden decisions. You may, for example, find that one of you makes a sudden move that impacts the other's life in far-reaching ways, or it may be that outside agencies conspire to create unexpected shocks. You may also find that this connection catalyzes long-held ideas into action, and dreams new truth into being. However you choose to work with this energy, it benefits you both to be aware that your impulses resonate with an almost exponential synergy.

Whatever your goal is at the moment, you practice master marksmanship. If you keep your eyes open, really try to learn what makes your partner tick, and accept what you see, you can make the most of unconventional attitudes and bold behavior. Composite Mars in weak conjunction (within 7.5 degrees) with Pluto

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

With this conjunction between composite Mars and Pluto, your relationship has a passionate intensity and also the potential for explosive conflict. There is a powerful connection between you based around the concept of self-assertion, either yours or your partner's, and one reason that you have come together at this time is to heal this issue in your lives. This aspect also signals a tremendous drive for power and transformation of self, forged in the combined energies of your partnership. Acting together as a team, you may appear strong-willed, almost to the point of ruthlessness, with enormous energy and endurance at your disposal. In a romantic connection, your sexual magnetism and activity is likely to be strong, as well as the issue of power and control that will crop up from time to time between you. The pattern of your relationship may be such that one of you appears timid or unsure to the

other partner much of the time, since the power urge when problematic commonly hides deep underground, but there is the potential for sudden

bursts of anger when repressed emotion finally finds its way to the surface. One or both of you may compensate for feelings of insecurity by being forceful, compulsive or even obsessive about achieving their will, leading to confrontation. **Composite Mars in weak opposition
(within 7.2 degrees) with Chiron**

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With this aspect in your composite chart you are likely to be engaged in a relationship in which there is difficulty and also great healing potential with expressing anger, exerting personal will or standing up versus knuckling under to authority. It may be that one or both of you have had painful experiences, perhaps in your early childhood, with violence or potential violence on the part of someone close to you. If so, you may fear the power of your own anger, or seek to placate your opponent in situations where a direct confrontation is brewing only to subtly retaliate later on, the hallmark of a "passive-aggressive" attitude. As you continually work through whatever arises in your daily interactions with each other, these types of issues may come up for acceptance and eventual healing. Since the powerful emotions associated with such woundings hover below the level of consciousness it is often the case that your self-awareness around them truly begins to manifest only in your relationship connection. You may also be called upon as a partnership to exert a beneficial influence regarding these issues on others around you. When you become more conscious and accepting of these patterns in yourself, as you work through them in the course of this relationship, you will less and less need to act them out either suppressed

with passivity or with bluster. A better level of integration is possible, producing a more self-assured and powerful personality.

**Composite Saturn in weak opposition
(within 4.6 degrees) with Uranus**

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect brings an impractical, eccentric and future-oriented quality to your relationship. You two may find you rebel against authority, and with your strong imagination and good conceptual level, you probably have good reason to want to do things in new and different ways. When you function at your best you have the capability to bring a concrete and real-world practicality to the intangible and visionary Uranian energy. It benefits you to learn to trust yourselves and your insights, and then to find a way to proceed in a steady, step by step fashion to ground your flashes of insight into an actual new way of being and doing in the world. You benefit when you learn to move away from a knee-jerk reaction either for or against established authority, toward establishing your own personal authority, in your own way, and to help make your brilliant visionary impulses concrete and available to society at large.

**Composite Saturn in weak trine
(within 6.0 degrees) with Neptune**

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This combination gives a clear thinking and discriminating relationship. Saturn brings an extremely practical dimension to the visionary idealism of Neptune. You two are responsible, compassionate, and take social issues very seriously. You may share an engaging interest in music, dance or film, or in the healing arts. You may suffer confusion regarding restrictions imposed upon you, in which you feel both attracted to the security imposed by such limits, and simultaneously repelled or stifled by these restrictions. With this placement, you the capacity to work with both energies, striking a balance between the Saturn's limits and Neptune's absolute lack of them. At its best, you two will find creative ways to use Saturn's sturdiness to anchor Neptune's visionary quality into practical forms. This placement can also indicate a relationship that has reached a level of spiritual attainment where you share a deep, subtle acceptance of whatever is happening. This state of

acceptance is no small thing, and in fact, it lies at the very heart of the esoteric teachings within most of the great religions.

Glossary

Ascendant: The point in the sky of the Eastern horizon. In the chart, the Ascendant is represented by the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart which crosses between the Twelfth and First Houses. The sign on the Ascendant is also referred to as the Rising Sign.

Aspects: When the relative positions of two planets in the horoscope form a significant angle with each other, they are said to be in aspect with one another. The type and quality of the aspect is determined by the number of degrees between the two planets and is only considered significant if it is within a narrow range of degrees, or orb. A list of the aspects used in this report is given below.

Conjunction — 0° ± 8 degrees	Square — 90° ± 8 degrees
Opposition — 180° ± 8 degrees	Sextile — 60° ± 6 degrees
Trine — 120° ± 8 degrees	Inconjunct — 150° ± 4 degrees

Chart Comparison: An astrological technique in which the planets of two individuals are shown in a bi-wheel chart, one within the other. This allows the inter-aspects between the two charts to be examined.

Composite Chart: An astrological technique in which the midpoints of two individuals' planetary positions are used to create a third chart, the composite chart, which is then interpreted as the chart of the relationship itself as an independent entity.

Horoscope: Originally horoscope referred to the astrological chart itself, but is now popularly used to refer to the description of how current planetary positions are affecting you personally, as in "your monthly horoscope."

Midheaven: The point in the sky directly overhead relative to the position on Earth. In the chart, the Midheaven is represented by the vertical line at the top of the chart between the Ninth and Tenth Houses.

Natal: From Latin, meaning of or pertaining to birth; therefore your birth chart,
or planetary positions at birth.

Nodes: The Lunar Nodes are the two points where the Moon's orbital path crosses the plane of the ecliptic (the plane of the Earth's orbit around the Sun). Symbolically they represent talents and life path, or destiny.

Planets: In astrology, the word planets is used to describe astrologically significant points in the sky which includes the Sun and Moon, as well as many objects that are not currently astronomically defined as planets such as Chiron and Pluto.

Transits: Aspects formed between the current positions of the planets and the positions of your natal planets at the time and place you were born.
